### POOMSE & SPARRING DIVISIONS

**ELIGIBILITY:** Any students from legitimate Tae Kwon Do schools that are in good standing with their dojang and instructors.

POOMSE BLACK BELT GRAND CHAMPIONSHIP: 1st place Black Belt winners (male & female age 11 & up divisions) may compete for overall Grand Champion in Black Belt Poomse. You will perform your ranking Black Belt Poomse. There will be one male & one female Grand Champion.

**SPARRING COMPETITION RULES:** Please refer to S.C. Gov Cup rules on next page.

**SPARRING**: All sparring divisions will consist of **No More** than four competitors per division. 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, and two 3<sup>rd</sup> places will be awarded in each division where applicable.

**AWARDS:** Beautiful custom medals will be awarded to 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, and 3<sup>rd</sup> place winners.

#### S.C. GOVERNOR'S CUP SPARRING COMPETITION RULES

<u>Duration of Matches</u>: All belts & all ages = 2 one minute rounds with 30 seconds rest in between rounds. **Rules regarding contact:** 

In divisions where head contact is allowed it should be controlled. Therefore excessive contact to the head should be avoided. Excessive contact to the head will result in a one point deduction or disqualification depending on severity. **KNOCKOUTS ARE NOT ALLOWED IN THIS EVENT.** 

- ♦ Adults 18 years and older (Color Belts & Black Belts): Full contact to legal body area with kicks and punches. Head contact is allowed but should be controlled.
- ♦ Ages 13 through 17 (Black Belts): Adult rules apply.
- ♦ Ages 13 through 17 (Color Belts): Full contact to the legal body area with kicks and punches. Kicks to the head will be allowed but must be <u>light contact</u>. Excessive force will result in a full point deduction and/or disqualification.
- ♦ Ages 9 12 (Black Belts): Full contact to the legal body area with kicks and punches. Kicks to the head will be allowed but must be <u>light contact</u>. Excessive force will result in a full point deduction and/or disqualification.
- ♦ Ages 12 years and under (Color Belts): Full contact to the legal body area but absolutely no contact to the head. Any contact to the head will result in a full point deduction or disqualification.

#### **Valid Scores/Points:**

- ♦ A valid punch to the body will be rewarded one point.
- ♦ A valid kick to the body will be rewarded two points. 1 additional bonus point for spinning kick.
- ♦ A valid kick to the opponent's head will be rewarded three points. 1 additional bonus point for spinning kick in adult divisions.

### **Full Point Deductions: (Gam Jang)**

One point deductions will be issued to a player each time he/she commits any of the following fouls: holding, escaping opponent by showing the back, intentionally going out of bounds, attacking with knees, throwing an opponent down, pretending injury, avoiding opponent by constantly moving around without fighting, attacking the groin area, pushing the opponent, falling, attacking the opponent's face with fist, and undesirable remarks or conduct from player or coach.

- ♦ Ten gam Jang penalties will result in disqualification of competitor.
- ♦ If a competitor cannot continue a match due to excessive head contact the attacker will be disqualified.
- ♦ Forfeiting a match: This will occur when a competitor loses his/her ability to fight due to loss of will, crying or fear.
- ♦ A match that ends in a tie will go into Sudden Death = first competitor to score a valid point will win the match.
